We are looking for adults 18 years and older diagnosed with **Multiple Myeloma** to examine the taste perceptions and changes to prevent malnutrition.

Many individuals with cancer develop taste changes that impact their nutritional status leading to a risk of malnutrition. This study aims to evaluate the taste perceptions of Oral Nutritional Supplements in cancer patients (multiple myeloma) and how this affects consumption.
